## Clinic Helps More Patients By Expanding Hours

Beginning on Monday, May 15, InterFaith expanded its hours to include an evening clinic from 5 p.m. to 9 p.m. on weeknights.

By expanding the clinic's hours, InterFaith hopes to increase the number of uninsured workers who can be served.

"With the state's TennCare cuts, a lot more patients are now in need of our services, and there's just no way we could accommodate them all with our normal eight to five schedule. Also, since InterFaith serves the working uninsured, the evening clinic is just more convenient for some patients who work during the day," said Melissa Knight, InterFaith's Executive Director.

One nurse practitioner, two nurses, and two front office employees staff the evening clinic, which is located at InterFaith's medical building on Gill Avenue. The four-person support staff was brought on to accommodate volunteer providers who also help staff the evening clinic. During the first week of expanded hours, InterFaith saw 25 new patients and equally as many existing patients during the evening clinic alone.

"We think the evening clinic is really going to meet a need in this community. It's taken some sacrifice on the part of our staff, but we're confident that expanding our services will also increase the number of patients we can help," Knight said.

With InterFaith's expanded hours, the clinic is now open until 9 p.m. Monday through Friday. Just like daytime medical care at InterFaith, an appointment is required for all patients visiting the evening clinic.

## A Message from our Executive Director

How many lives have you touched?

Would it comfort you to know that when you walked down a busy street, you passed someone that you have never seen, but you had impacted his/her life in a way no one else ever had? Each of you that have given of your time, money and talents have touched many, many lives that you will never see.

The obvious lives that we touch are the lives of the patients. If you volunteer in direct patient care, you are privileged to meet these individuals and see the impact of your time and talents. For those of us who don't provide direct patient care, but are in the clinic either as staff or volunteer, we see on a limited scale the impact on our patients' lives. We meet them in the hall or read their letters of thanks. For those of us who give monetarily, we have the assurance of knowing that your money provided the needed supplies to wrap a hurt foot, take an x-ray, or give a child an antibiotic. On some level we can all grasp the impact of quality healthcare to our patients.

What I think we miss is the impact this has on many people that never walk through our doors.

We don't see the third-grade child who got to school on time, well rested with completed homework because their mother had access to healthcare so she could receive her annual physical and cervical cancer was found in time.

We don't see the daughter whose father walked her down the aisle or the son whose father stood as his best man because the father had access to diagnostic testing that led to a stint to prevent a heart attack several years before.



We don't see the pride in an individual who is able to continue to work and provide for his family. A few years earlier he had the beginning of neuropathy due to untreated diabetes. Once he gained access to diabetic education and proper medication, he was able to prolong his "working" years.

We don't see the relief in a mother's face when her 35-year-old son tells her that he now has a doctor and can afford treatment for his hypertension. She lost her husband to stroke at a young age.

We don't see the many lives touched by a young therapist. While he was in graduate school his father lost his job. Although this father found a job, he no longer had benefits. Until his parents were 65 and received Medicare, they were our patients. Today, he schedules a certain number of "sliding fee" visits for individuals in his community to give back.

For each of you who have given of your time, money and talents – you have touched more lives than you will ever comprehend. May God bless you as you have blessed so many others.

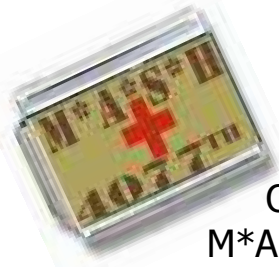
## How Can I Help InterFaith?
