Sponsored by the Greater Knoxville Sertoma Club, the Knoxville Health Underwriters, and The Big Orange Army, the tailgate party is an 11th- annual event in Knoxville, with the proceeds benefiting InterFaith. This year's event raised \$21,000 for InterFaith.

"InterFaith couldn't succeed in providing affordable healthcare without the community's support," he said.

It is hard to believe that another year has come and just about gone. We are so blessed at InterFaith. We have the privilege to be a part of something so unique. All day, everyday, we provide medical, dental, and mental healthcare to the low income working uninsured.

We are unique because that is all we do. It is not a part of what we do when we have time or when we don't have a something else distracting us – the low income, working uninsured patient is our focus, our mission. We are unique because we are truly an example of our community taking care of our community. We have over 400 volunteers who give of their time, money and talents to provide care. We operate on local donations. Approximately 92% of money comes from local individuals, foundations, and congregations. We are unique because people from different religious denominations come together to work for a common purpose. Emphasis is placed on being a servant; not arguing about a style of worship. We are unique because our patients are looking for a hand up – not a hand out. Our patients get up and go to work. They aren't looking for free care. They pay on a sliding fee scale according to their income and number of people in their household.



a patient asked if he could have a few minutes of my time. He followed me in my office carrying a small paper bag. Our conversation began with his question regarding the "donor fatigue" he kept hearing about on the television with everyone giving to crisis out of state. Then he shared his story, which covered several years that he, his wife and son had been patients of the clinic. His son was no longer a patient because he was grown and had a "good job with insurance." As his story continued he shared with me about his wife's cancer. How we had first provided the diagnosis. Then we had set into motion our off-site volunteers. The oncologists, radiologists, pathologists, treatments, hospital stays, etc. He spoke with almost reverence as he described the respect and concern that had been demonstrated to their family while they receive quality treatment. Originally, they had been told without treatment she would have less than six months. With the treatment, she lived two and a half years. She had died just a few months earlier. He preceded to hand me the small paper bag. This was the money he and his son had saved to buy each other Christmas presents. They had decided that with all the "donor fatigue" going around, they needed to give the money to the clinic so someone else's mother, someone else's wife could receive the same care their loved one had received.

I had a hard time opening presents a few days later on Christmas morning. My mind kept going back to that gentleman and his son. On behalf of all of our patients – thank you for making a difference. Personally, I am thankful to work side by side with each of you. We are truly blessed.

Gifts-in-Kind Lower Costs

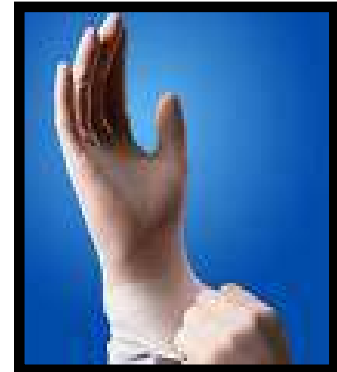

InterFaith Fast Facts

-  Since InterFaith opened its doors in March of 1991, the clinic has had more than 153,000 on-site patient visits.
-  Because InterFaith realizes that primary care is only a fraction of a healthy patient, the clinic also offers dental care, eye care, mental health counseling, and affordable medications.
-  Patient fees comprise only 23% of InterFaith's income - the remaining income is made up in donations from organizations and individuals.
-  With a staff of only 32, InterFaith relies on nearly 200 on-site volunteers.
-  More than 400 specialty physicians team with InterFaith to provide healthcare services at their private offices and charge according to the clinic's sliding fee scale.
-  Approximately 91% of the clinic's income goes directly to patient care.

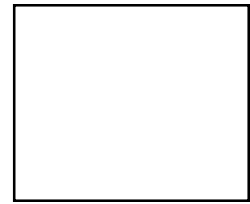
